

## Post-Pinyin Conversion Cleanup Project (PPCCP)

### Phase II Summary Report

I would like to express my sincere appreciation to all of the participants for their cooperative efforts and voluntary quality assurance contributions to the OCLC WorldCat and OCLC CJK Users Group in the past several months. The following is a summary report on the project:

- PPCCP Phase II operation lasted from May 2004 to December 2004.
- Phase II work was shared by participating institutions on a voluntary basis.
- Phase II work reviewed and updated records containing the conversion flaws left from Phase I review and update work.
- Phase II distribution of review target records was made based on "held-by participant institutions" scan result from OCLC.
- Total records scanned out as "review required" on May 20, 2004: 7,253
- Total records scanned out as "not-yet-reviewed" on December 22, 2004: 3,338
- Total records corrected during 7 months: 3,915 (54%) by participants.

*Note: Because these figures are based on the sum of individual institutions "held-by" records, it is highly possible that one record is held by more than one institution in WorldCat. Therefore, the figure does not reflect the absolute count of target records.*

PPCCP Phase I and Phase II could not cover the entire update workload even we put our collective efforts to make WorldCat records cleaner. When you still hit records with conversion flaws, please update such records or report them to OCLC.
